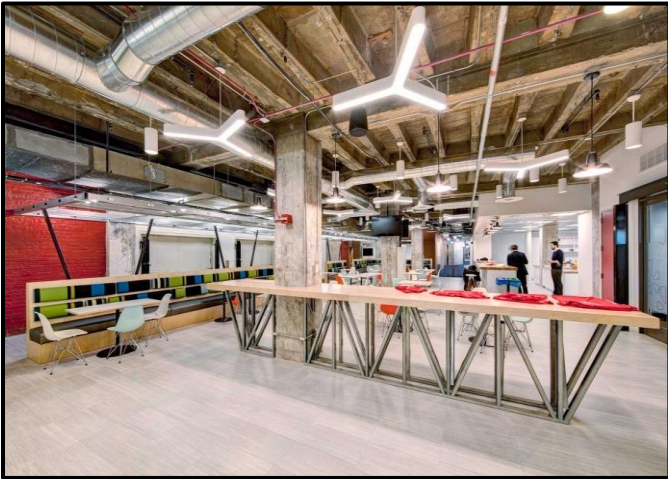




# Titan Electric

Titan Electric was the electrical subcontractor for Yelp's 50,300 square-foot office build-out in Chicago's Merchandise Mart.

A global online business-review company that connects people with great local businesses, ranging from shops and mechanics to restaurants and dentists, Yelp's other office locations include San Francisco, Scottsdale, New York, London, Dublin and Hamburg, Germany.

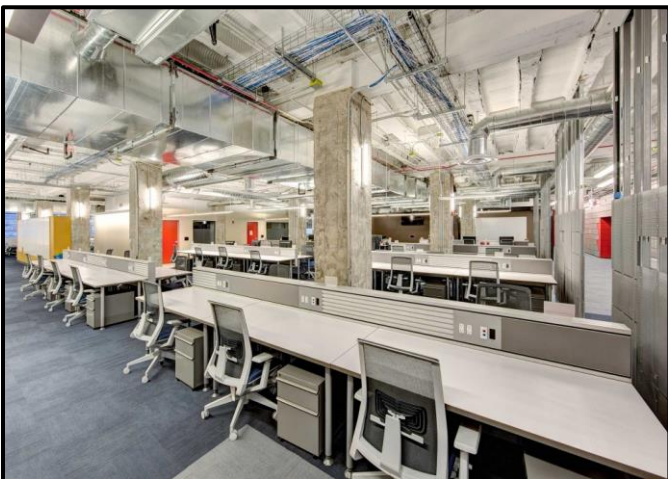
This renovation pays tribute to the rich history and architecture of Chicago, with conference rooms named after landmarks such as Navy Pier and Wrigley Field, and work areas designed to resemble "L" stations.

Project details include the addition of a café with in-house baristas, a game and entertainment space, a full catering kitchen and kegerator, and a genius bar. Departments from sales to finance are located in open office/benching environments with cutting-edge AV and data technology, and the HR department is surrounded by a unique steel "L" car wrap. A complete mechanical system and technology infrastructure to support 375 desks was also installed.

Titan Electric's involvement included the installation of:

- UPS for power backup
- Exposed cable tray system
- Complete conduit system for security, audio visual and fire alarm systems
- Lighting control system with daylight sensors
- Wiring to 375 workstations
