VETRO CONDOMINIUMS



Titan Electric furnished all the electrical work at the 31-story luxury high-rise Vetro condominium at 611 South Wells Street in the South Loop neighborhood of Printers Row in Chicago.

The building features the unique use of blue tinted glass to cover the entire exterior. The combination of glass, concrete and steel creates a totally modern look, but still retains the feel of Chicago's classic neighborhoods.

The facility contains 233 condominiums, as well as 10 Penthouse Suites. Units come in several different floor plans, ranging from 500 to 2,000 square feet, with either one or two-bedroom options. Other amenities include the 7th floor terrace; a business center; a workout room; a bike room; spa facilities; and six floors of indoor parking.
