Titan Electric completed six major Chicago public school renovations for the Chicago Public Building Commission. Finished on a fast-track, six-week schedule, renovations included Edward C. Delano Elementary School, Helen M. Hefferan Elementary School and George W. Tilton Elementary School (West Garfield Park neighborhood); Edward K. Ellington Elementary School and Horatio May Elementary Community Academy (Austin neighborhood) and John Milton Gregory Elementary School (East Garfield Park neighborhood).



Across more than 600,000 square feet of academic space, interior renovations featured new computer labs, media centers, science labs, nearly 120 classrooms and fully operational air conditioning systems. Accessibility upgrades and a new security system were also provided at John Milton Gregory Elementary School.

As a result of the Chicago Public School's commitment to new learning technologies, each student received an I-Pad on the first day of school.

Titan's involvement included:

- Installation of wireless access points
- Low Voltage infrastructure for new student IPAD implementation
- Power distribution for workstations, audio visual presentations and smart-boards
- Power distribution for new climate controls, heating and air systems
- Service distribution, panels and metering through coordination with local utility
