## PROVINCE RESTAURANT



Titan Electric was chosen as the electrical subcontractor for Province Restaurant's eco-friendly interior build-out located in the Chicago Transit Authority building in the West Loop neighborhood.

The renovation was the very first restaurant designated by the U.S. Green Building Council as LEED Gold in downtown Chicago.

Features of the 4,200 square foot restaurant include seating for 140, highly-efficient mechanical and lighting systems, and Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)-certified wood that is formaldehyde-free. The kitchen has a poured floor which is more durable and earth-friendly than standard quarry tile. The private dining room is separated from the main dining area by an 8-foot tall wall of custom lighting encased in a custom climate-controlled wine storage enclosure that holds only biodynamic, sustainable and organic wine.
