AMC YORKTOWN 18 RENOVATION



Titan Electric was the electrical subcontractor for AMC Yorktown 18, a 68,000 square foot facility adjacent to Yorktown Mall. Located in Lombard, IL, renovations were completed in phases while the 18 theatres were in operation. This required careful coordination to keep systems in place for areas still in operation.

Project highlights include the demolition and renovation of auditoriums, restrooms, concession areas, the box office and the lobby. Each theatre was outfitted with power reclining seats and tables to accommodate fast-casual dining. Other highlights include the build-out of an AMC Red Kitchen, featuring the ability of guests to enjoy a meal during the movie from the comfort of their power recliner. Also added was MacGuffins, a new bar and lounge that serves specialty cocktails, beer and wine.

A partial list of Titan's work included the installation of:

- Power and low voltage raceways to over 540 auditorium reclining chairs for Plexcall and Orderman systems allowing customers to order food and drink directly from seats
- Electrical panels to assist with reclining chair power
- Power to convenience tables located at theatre seats to identify location of food/drink order to wait staff and to kitchen equipment throughout the kitchen, bar and concessions areas
- Lighting including Tivoli aisle lighting and light fixture upgrades
- Fire alarm, security and card access systems

Leopardo Companies, Inc. was the general contractor for the project with architectural services provided by BRR Architecture.
