GENTILE CENTER – LOYOLA UNIVERSITY



Titan Electric was chosen as the electrical contractor for a major renovation to Loyola University's Joseph J. Gentile Center on its Lake Shore Campus in Chicago.

This 45,000 square foot, 4,486-seat multi-purpose arena is used primarily by Loyola's men's and women's athletic teams, but is also available to the student body and the neighborhood community. Graduations, intramural activities, concerts and recitals all take place at the Center.

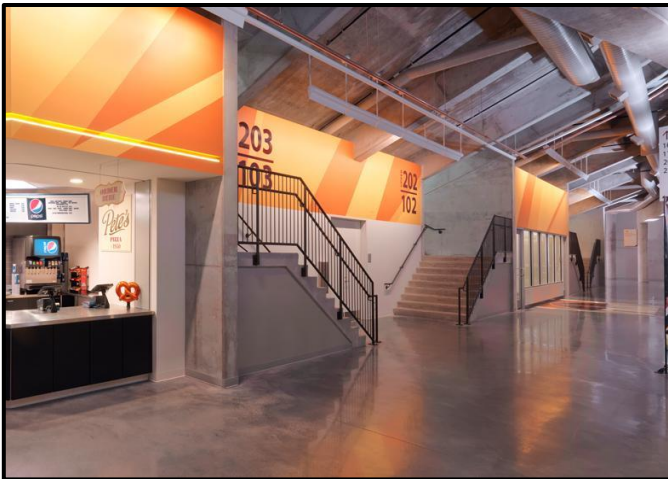
The original building was completely gutted with only the four original walls and ceiling left untouched. Large decks of bleachers were replaced with much-improved accommodations including a lower bowl that has chair-back seats.

A four-sided video board above center court was installed, along with smaller video boards in facing corners and a wide LED display along the scorer's table. A new concourse was added with a large concession area, updated restrooms and a new gift shop.

A few of the items installed by Titan included:

- Power distribution
- Energy-efficient light fixtures
- LED lighting
- Programmed and building-certified fire alarm system
